



Summer Uniform Arrangements: May 2018

- ◆ Students should ALWAYS bring their blazer to school.
- ◆ Even on the sunniest day, they should arrive at 8.40am in form room/ assembly with blazer on – it won't be THAT hot by that time of day.
- ◆ Unless a school-wide communication is sent, they should arrive to all lessons in their blazer, which they can then be immediately given permission to take off by the class teacher.
- ◆ Uniform should remain in line with appearance expectations, as on p9 of the journal, in all other respects e.g. top button done up, tie correct, shirt tucked in
- ◆ On very hot days, a school wide email may be sent, by admin staff on behalf of SLT, informing staff and students that blazers can remain off for the whole day. In extreme circumstances, this notification might also allow the unbuttoning of the top button and/or the rolling up of sleeves for those in long sleeved shirts – this to be decided at each occurrence of particularly hot weather, again by SLT.
- ◆ Students challenged about uniform should correct without delay or argument, as on any other day. Anyone unable to do so should be escorted to relevant LM.
