Challenge yourself to read something you wouldn't normally read!
It could be:

- A genre you don't normally read (fantasy, crime, sci-fi, horror, etc.)
- A classic novel you've heard a lot about (Frankenstein, The Diary of Anne Frank, Oliver Twist).
- Your parent or carer's favourite book!
- Any other challenging text.

What is a book review?

A book review is a summary of the plot, the characters in the story and how the book made you feel. It should **evaluate** how written the book was and how much you enjoyed it.

There are some questions below which you may find helpful to consider when completing your review.

Why did you challenge yourself to read this book in particular?
What is the book called, who wrote it, and when was it written?
What happened in the story? What was the story about?

What was the climax of the story? How did it end?

Who were the main characters? Did they change, if so how?

Was there anything interesting about the way it was written? Was it written in first or third person?

What was your favourite moment in the story? Why?

Would you recommend this book? Who would you recommend it to?

There'll be prizes for the most well-written piece, and the piece with the best illustrations!
